Virtual attendees will have their audio and video muted until asked to raise their “virtual” hand to be recognized to speak. Individuals will be given a specified amount of time for their comments. Online registration only allows for virtual participation and an in-person sign-up only allows for in-person participation.

Public Comment: Members of the public wishing to address the Board of Commissioners may do so during the Public Comment session and can speak on any topic not scheduled for a public hearing at the same meeting. In-person sign-ups are accepted beginning 15 minutes before the meeting starts through the end of the Public Comment session. Virtual sign-ups are accepted through the end of the Public Comment session (individuals must be logged into the Zoom meeting before the end of Public Comment in order to be called on to speak).

Public Hearings: Members of the public can provide comment during a public hearing on a specific agenda item which will be included as testimony for that public hearing. In-person sign-ups are accepted beginning 15 minutes before the start of the meeting and close at the start of the public hearing. Virtual sign-ups are accepted up to the start of the public hearing (individuals must be logged into the Zoom meeting by the start of the public hearing to be called on to speak).
