



EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT AUTHORIZATION FORM

EXEMPTION: Pursuant LM 20.200.120 (C) Certain contracts may be awarded without competitive selection, if an Emergency exists that requires prompt execution of those contract(s) to preserve public funds, property, or the uninterrupted provision of government services.

For this exemption, Emergency is defined as circumstances that could not have been reasonably foreseen, and create a substantial risk of loss, damage, or interruption of services, or a threat to property, public health, or safety, as provided in ORS 279A.010 (f).

The County must ensure competition for the contract that is reasonable and appropriate under the emergency circumstances, which may include direct award of contracts, limiting competitive process or duration, waiving of normally required bonds.

Method of Supplier Selection: Direct Award Limited Competition Waiver of Bonds

Emergency contracts must be limited to work that is necessary and appropriate to remedy the conditions creating the Emergency.
